



Revelation 12-3 v. 13-17



¹³ Now when the dragon saw that he had been cast to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male Child. 14 But the woman was given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, where she is nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent.

Chapter 12 can read like 3-act play:

Act 1: <u>History</u> of God's plan through Israel (woman with the 12 stars, waiting to give birth), Messiah (male child born to the woman) and enemy (dragon) shown on "movie screen" of heavens.

ACT 2: War in heaven, most likely yet to come, resulting in enemy being cast out and followers thrown to earth. *Mad!*

ACT 3: <u>God delivers Israel</u> (*woman*) from enemy's persecution, brings her to place of divine protection (already prepared for her).

- Remember <u>correct identity of woman</u>. Israel, not Church. Satan very angry, knows time short, now turns full fury against Israel. Has always desired to devour Israel/her Messiah.
- However, in verse 17, enemy frustrated about Israel, so <u>turns</u> his attention to "her offspring."
- *"two wings of a great eagle..."* Eagles often used in scripture as symbolic for divine deliverance.

- Obviously, nation of Israel not on some gigantic eagle!
- Remember, take literally whatever CAN be taken literally, and look for <u>scriptural</u> interpretation of passages obviously symbolic.
- Some try to make eagle symbol for USA. <u>Big, unfounded</u>, stretch –considering Zechariah 12:3 (all nations against *Israel*) and US waning support.
- Always look for Biblical interpretation first. Eagles are a known scriptural symbol for God's protection and deliverance.

- "...fly into the wilderness..." discussed possibility of <u>Petra</u> literal place God sets aside for His people.
- However, <u>another important note about</u>
 <u>this wilderness compared to another</u>
 <u>wilderness</u>.
- So many <u>references and allusions</u> to the events in Exodus in the book of Revelation is somewhat uncanny.




In fact, there are major parallels to Revelation in almost every other book of scripture. Especially two we will take brief side tours through: **Daniel and Zechariah** These contain information critical to understanding Revelation.

Beginning next lesson we will spend a great deal of time looking at all these books to help us understand Revelation better. In particular, we will dive into the books of **Daniel** and Zechariah, part of the Apocalyptic Triangle.



When God delivered Israel out of Egypt...

- Sent them a deliverer.
- He brought them into wilderness.
- Protected, separated from rest of world so God could teach, build them into nation He intended.
- During entire wilderness experience, <u>God provided for</u> <u>ALL needs, physical and spiritual</u>.
- All food and water was provided, protection was afforded, guidance and teaching given.

- Israel's "nourishment" in wilderness (from Egypt) both body and spirit. Likely same will happen in wilderness (Petra or some other place).
- God will divinely protect/provide, will teach them and guide them into truth <u>and</u> saving relationship with His Son, their Deliverer.
- And *"they will look on Me, whom they pierced."* (Zech. 12:10)
- Israel protected from serpent's wrath in this time.




- "a time and times and half a time…" Once again given exact length of this period of time.
- From Daniel we know that a
 "time" = one year, "times" = two
 years, "half a time" = ½ year.
 Total, 3½ years (360 day years).
- No question how long a time this is. <u>Literal period of time, not</u> <u>allegorical</u>.

¹⁵ So the serpent spewed water out of his mouth like a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood. ¹⁶ But the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed up the flood which the dragon had spewed out of his mouth.



- Devil frustrated by divine protection of Israel. Can't get to her. In anger, he *"spewed water out of his mouth like a flood."*
- Literal? Actually a flood of water in the desert? Well, could be, but likely a euphemism, one used before in scripture, for military force, or a great force of opposition.



 Daniel 9:26 (part of Daniel's 70 weeks) speaks of destruction of Temple in 70 AD reads:

"And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; And the people of the prince who is to come Shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. <u>The end of it shall be with a flood</u>, And till the end of the war desolations are determined."



Temple not destroyed with literal flood, but by "flood" of soldiers and military might (Roman armies) against Israel at that time.

- Isaiah 59:19: "So shall they fear The name of the LORD from the west, And His glory from the rising of the sun; When the enemy comes in like a flood, The Spirit of the LORD will lift up a standard against him."
- Many references to <u>enemy forces like force of a flood</u>.
- Perhaps relates to military response by final world leader to try to destroy Israel even under God's protection.
- This enemy plan, whatever it is, is foiled.

- "But the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed up the flood..." No reason to believe this NOT literal. <u>Earth does nothing without</u> <u>command from her Creator</u>.
- God has done this before. Numbers 16:31 (also Numbers 26, Deuteronomy 11, Psalm 106), God opened earth to swallow up some disobedient Israelites.



 Micah 7:15 = God will work just like He did in deliverance from Egypt, against enemies of Israel, in end times.

As in the days when you came out of the land of Egypt, I will show them wonders. The nations shall see and be ashamed of all their might; They shall put their hand over their mouth; Their ears shall be deaf. They shall lick the dust like a serpent; They shall crawl from their holes like snakes of the earth. They shall be afraid of the LORD [YAHWEH] our God, And shall fear because of You.

World truly in awe of wonders of Elohim at this time!

- Whether literal flood of water, or flood of military action at Petra (or wherever she is in the wilderness), God will open the earth and swallow this evil meant to destroy the apple of His eye (Israel).
- "Left Behind" series, LaHaye portrays as a massive military move, swallowed literally into the earth, perhaps by an earthquake. It's possible for our God!
- Whatever happens, God delivers Israel from harm. And this enrages the enemy.

¹⁷ And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

• Dragon throws huge temper tantrum. Enraged with Israel (woman), but cannot do anything to her.

- In rage, turned to next in line, *"her offspring"* (literally, *"remnant of her seed"*).
- <u>Don't have to wonder who this is</u>. Again, Word provides answer. They are *"those who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ."*
- These offspring = Believers, who come to Jesus during tribulation <u>tribulation saints</u>. Persecution heats up.

- *"...who keep the <u>commandments of God</u> and have the <u>testimony of Jesus Christ</u>." These <u>two identifiers</u> may <i>indicate* these are more precisely <u>Messianic Jews</u>.
- Could even be sealed 144,000 (*ch 7*). Reference to "the commandments" [the Law] and to the witness of Jesus [grace] (*old and new covenants*).
- Those now persecuted could be Jewish believers. However, could also be reference to <u>any believer at this</u> <u>time</u>, Jew or Gentile. May also include entire covenant people of God.

- Cannot underestimate how horrible and gruesome these times will be for believers, (Jew and Gentile), but especially for Jews.
- Zechariah makes this very clear: "And it shall come to pass in all the land," Says the LORD, "<u>That two-thirds in it</u> shall be cut off and die, But one-third shall be left in it: I will bring the one-third through the fire, Will refine them as silver is refined, And test them as gold is tested. They will call on My name, And I will answer them. I will say, 'This is My people'; And each one will say, 'The LORD is my **God.**" (Zechariah 13:8-9)


- During time of "Jacob's Trouble," the Great Tribulation, 2/3 of the Jews will die. Passage <u>deals specifically with</u> <u>Israel</u>.
- But 1/3 spared, also "refined" through persecution and testing, emerge as remnant of <u>true believers, strengthened by</u> <u>God and standing firm for Him.</u>

But the people who know their God shall STAND FIRM and take action. Daniel 11:32

Now ready for introduction to dragon's "henchmen" – the beast from the sea, and the beast from the land in chapter 13. An unholy trinity.
